Would it be beneficial for my family?

- Weekend Wheels is a supplemental weekend food program that provides a backpack on wheels to elementary age children to bring home on Fridays filled with food and snack items. Back packs are returned on Mondays to be repacked for the upcoming Friday. This program distributes through John F. Kennedy, Clover Street, Oliver Ellsworth and Poquonock Schools. Homeschooled families can also participate.
- Food provided in the backpacks help supplement food costs on weekends.
- Eligibility for the program is based on household income. See below. **If you qualify for free or reduced school meals you are automatically qualified for Weekend Wheels.** The table below shows a yearly gross income for each family size. If your household income is at or below the income listed for the number of people in your household, you are eligible to receive TEFAP commodities. (235% of poverty).
