Flooding on Pleasant Street

When severe flooding or other emergency situations threaten the safety of Windsor residents, the Everbridge emergency notification system can alert you and your family.

The Everbridge emergency notification system enables the Town of Windsor to provide you with critical information in a variety of situations, such as severe weather, evacuations, unexpected road closures, water outages, missing persons or criminal activity.

You may recall receiving an emergency telephone message last spring advising residents to take necessary precautions in response to the severe flooding that impacted many Windsor neighborhoods.

This emergency notification system was funded by the State of Connecticut so all communities would have the capability of notifying their residents in the event of an emergency.

Later this fall, Windsor residents will also have the opportunity to “opt-in” to receive non-emergency telephone notifications. These might include alerts on traffic or road closures, police activity or facility closures, to name a few. Receiving these notifications will be completely optional and you will receive these time-sensitive messages wherever you specify, such as your home phone, cell, or business phone, or by email or text messages.
