



Luminary Decorating Guidelines

If your organization is interested in decorating luminaries for the event, please review the guidelines below and contact Enita Jubrey at 860-285-1835.



On Sunday, September 11, 2011, the decorated luminaries will be displayed along the sidewalks of the Windsor Town Green. At dusk, they will be illuminated with glow sticks. A remembrance ceremony featuring Windsor Fire, Police and EMS personnel as well as Windsor Clergy will begin at 7:00 PM. Following this ceremony, those in attendance can stroll the town green and view the bags, providing an opportunity for families to reflect in their own way.

- Each bag represents an individual who lost their life on 9/11 and their name has been printed on the bags that will be provided to you. Please keep the name visible. All other areas of the bag are fair game for drawings, poems, letters, stickers or any other appropriate art medium.
- The bags may be decorated in any fashion, but please refrain from the use of magic markers as they may bleed through the paper bag.
- There are several 9/11 family websites available on the internet that may provide biographical information of various individuals. If desired, you can learn about the person you are decorating a luminary for and possibly customize your drawings or writings to that individual. This is optional - not required.
- It is very important that all luminary bags are returned, so it is recommended groups meet together to decorate luminaries as opposed to anyone bringing one home to decorate.
- The bags are in bundles of 25 each.
